
Emperor's Children Swords - Mamikon Patreon

In this tutorial I will show you how to paint Emperor's Children Swords. Let's get into the tutorial!




We will start by adding a base coat with Leadbelcher mixed in a 1:1 ratio with water. We will need to apply 1-2 thin coats of this paint to achieve a smooth result. Make sure the previous coat of paint is fully dry before you apply the next one.



Next, we will add purple shading on both sides of the blade with **Luxion Purple Contrast** paint mixed in a 1:3 ratio with water. Make sure the shading is on the opposite ends of the sword on each side.



Next, we will use a 1:2 mix of black and Luxion Purple Contrast paint, mixed in a 1:4 ratio with water, to add darker shading on both ends of the sword. Make sure this only covers the 30% of the purple shading you have added before on the very ends of the blade.



Next, we will add a highlight on the edges of the sword with Stormhost Silver mixed in a 1:1 ratio with water.



In the final step of this tutorial, we will use Stormhost Silver mixed in a 1:1 ratio with water to add a few scratches on the blade. This step is optional.
